Hi, I am V.E.T. Net teacher Enkhtuya. Praise and thanks to God the Father who knows each and every person by name. I am so grateful for His care for my new friend in Jesus – Otgondelger. She is a young widow with two children. She lives in Selenge aimag, Zuunburen County. Our team met her in fall of 2020. Four of us V.E.T. Netters went to Selenge Aimag to give the Gifts of Love to needy families in Selenge Aimag. I will share with you about her life and testimony of coming to know Jesus.

Otgondelger's story - *My name is Otgondelger. My dear husband died of cancer, leaving me with two daughters. Who would have thought that difficult times would come. I realized that illness is a very difficult thing to deal with. I faced the bitter truth as my husband passed away – I realized that the strong could bully the weak. After my husband's funeral, my mother-in-law took my livestock and kicked me and my two daughters out of our home. That time my daughters were the only reason and motivation to pursue life.*

*In 2020, a V.E.T. Net team came to my hometown - Zuunburen County, Selenge aimag and gave the biggest gift that I have ever received. That day, four V.E.T. Net people – Teachers Enkhtuya, Uugantsetseg, Amarzorig and driver Ganbold, came to my mother's home where me and my daughters were taking shelter. Teacher Amarzorig talked about Jesus and I listened to them in remembrance of my mother. I showed them the book, the Bible, which was very much treasured by my mother. My mother was the first Christian in my family but she died because of illness. When she was alive she was part of the Jesus' people.*

*That day V.E.T. Net teacher Enkhtuya and I became friends. I believe that she is an angel sent to me by my mother. I do believe so. Enkhtuya became very close – near and dear to me. She invited me to her church in Ulaanbaatar. Later I went there and felt care and joy from her church people. That day Enkhtuya gave me this Audio Bible. Enkhtuya asked if I would like to get contacted with the church leader woman in Zuunburen County – my hometown. I am so glad that she thought of this. Shortly after I attended the congregation, this COVID lockdown started. During this time I read and listened to the Bible. Enkhtuya sent to me stories from Our Daily Bread devotional via Facebook chats. I did not feel lonely. I had my friend – teacher Enkhtuya.*

*My daughters love to listen to the Audio Bible and sing and dance in the worship music. Audio Bible comes very handy when I don't have time to sit down and read the Bible. I send my two daughters to school and kindergarten and listen to it while doing house chores. The Bible teachings and worship songs give me a lot, a lot a lot.*

*I said, I met with the church leader in my hometown Zuunburen. I treasure this relationship, too. On Christmas day, she brought Christmas gifts for my daughters, and some food supply. What a care and treat. I do not feel hopeless anymore. I found joy and love in Jesus.*
