Tuyasaikhan in Khalzan

Tuyasaikhan lives in Sukhbaatar Aimag, Khalzan County. She is a widow with 3 children. She lost her husband because of cancer. Her husband spent his last few years of life in a wheelchair. He was a Christian. On Sundays, Tuyasaikhan pushed the wheelchair for him. Whenever he went to church, Tuyasaikhan went with him. After he died, she continued going to church. She works as a janitor for the local governors' office. The small amount of salary barely meets her family needs. So, we gave her three sheep in 2019.

In spring of 2022, our team went to Sukhbaatar Aimag. On this trip we visited with the local Christian brothers and sisters to encourage their faith. Our visit with Tuyasaikhan encouraged us very much. Tuyasaikhan was a smart steward over the three sheep we gave her as a gift of love. She used one of the sheep for winter food and bartered the other two for four goats. The goats gave her cashmere in spring – some income for her family. Then the goats multiplied and in three years she has over 10 goats. Thus, her family have small herd helping them to survive. The Gift of love is meeting the needs of this young Christian family in Sukhbaatar Aimag, Khalzan County.

On this trip our team studied from the book of Revelations. Gerald taught us many details about the last days, about Antichrist, the judgement etc. Since the COVID quarantine, local churches struggled to survive. Believers in rural churches became lethargic. Sunday services, prayer meetings and bible study times had been stopped and believers were slow to come back to the normal habit of gathering together for such purposes. Therefore, our team rotated through the local churches in Sukhbaatar Aimag to

encourage them to focus on God's Word and Christian fellowship.

The last village we visited in Sukhbaatar Aimag was Tumentsogt County. There we met with Jargal, our old friend. Years ago she heard the Good News of Jesus Christ from V.E.T. Net staff and invited Jesus into her heart. She received the gift of love in 2018 and she started coming to church in Tumentsogt. During COVID quarantine, cults such as New Heaven and New Earth recruited people to their cult. Their online Bible teachings attracted many people during this time; even Christians were attracted to them. Jargal was one of these Christians. I was praying for her as I heard about this from the local church leaders.

The day we came to Tumentsogt was Sunday and we went to the local church. Jargal was not there, so in the evening I went to Jargal's home. There she had booklets from that cult. I started the conversation – discussion about the book of Revelation. She enthusiastically talked about this book. As you might know, cults such as New Heaven and New Earth talks about the last days a lot. After discussing about the last days, I told her to come back to church. I was able to convince her that this New Heaven and New Earth is a wrong path. I was
