My name is Khandaa. In summer of 2022, I served as a summer teacher in Bulgan Aimag, Khutag-Undur County. After the summer school was over I joined V.E.T.Net as a fulltime teacher staff. In October of 2022, our team of teacher Pagmaa, accountant Saikhnaa, driver Nergui short-term volunteers Dr. Phil and his wife Kathy and myself, Khandaa, served in Erdensant, Lun, Zuunmod, Sergelen, Arkhust, Mungunmorit Counties distributing sheep, telling about God – sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ to these families. Wherever we went there were needy and sick people with heartbreaking stories. One of them was Khurelbaatar. I am glad that the local government chose them as the eligible GOL recipient family.

Khurelbaatar is 63 years old. He and his wife Saranchimeg have three children. Two are grown up and have their own families. Khurelbaatar had a hemorrhagic stroke in 2002 followed subsequent episodes

in 2010 and 2012 after which he was unable to speak. It has been 22 years since he has needed his wife for everything. Khurelbaatar can hear very well and communicates exclusively through eye motions. He broke his right arm after falling off a chair in 2020. Then in May 2022, trying to use crutches to go outside, he collapsed and broke his leg and tailbone. He needed orthopedic surgery to fix his tailbone. He was paralyzed afterwards and is no longer able to go outside on his own.

Saranchimeg devotedly cared for Khurelbatar for many years. Then she got sick. She had a liver cancer surgery in 2013 and had 75% of her liver removed. Due to this surgery, she was constantly

exhausted quite exhausted. Caring for her husband became almost impossible. So their younger daughter moved in with them and has been taking care of them.

This family received the Gift of Love. We gave them three sheep. Khurelbaatar was delighted to hear about Jesus. We went to his home to share the good news of Jesus. When we asked him if he wanted to have Jesus in his life, he gently nodded. Since he could not say words, teacher Pagmaa prayed on behalf of him. Thus, he prayed salvation prayer with us.

Khurelbaatar's wife, Saranchimeg, was overjoyed as she heard about the sheep we brought for them. She said, "We buy our medicine with our pension, and we are often in food shortage."

We went back to Ulaanbaatar and are keeping in touch with Saranchimeg through phone calls. She is still very thankful for the help. She said that Khurelbaatar listens to the Audio Bible all the time. She also told us that her husband, Khurelbaatar, was extremely appreciative of all the gifts – the three sheep, the Good News, the Audio Bible and caring friends.

We are extremely grateful to God for the opportunity of being part of Gift of Love project and ministry. Even though visiting needy families breaks our hearts it's the Gift of Love comforts my heart. Like, GOL brought salvation to Khurelbaatar family.
