Greetings in the peace of the Lord. In Umnugobi Aimag we have 39 families receiving Gift of love. One of these people was Tserev. Tserev is 86 year old crippled woman. My heart ached as I heard the reason she was chosen to receive the sheep for Gift of Love but rejoiced when she prayed to invite Jesus in her heart.

Grandmother T. Tserev was born and raised in the Umnugobi Aimag, Bayan-Ovoo County. She is 86 years old. She gave birth to her first born when she was 17 years old. Then she was treated with a mysterious injection. This is mysterious because she was told that it should prevent her from sexually transmitted disease which was widespread at that time. Long story short, she was paralyzed after this treatment. However, she gave birth to nine more children and raised them up. She gave two of her children to adoption. Tserev lived a life

full of hard work and challenges caused by soviet government. She was one of many herders who worked for the government. This means she had to work so hard every day and provide the government with all the animal products, milk, meat, wool and the offspring. Thankfully she had a caring husband who did his best to live with her until he died at age of 70. Then her older daughter was murdered by her husband.

Now she lives with one of her sons in a tiny little ger. She welcomed us in her little ger and offerd us hot milk tea, freshly baked boortsog (fried dough food). We told her about God and asked her if she had ever heard of Jesus. she said –

I have, I pray to this God; but it looked like she has very little knowledge of who Jesus is. She sounded like she was tired of life and depressed. She said, "I don't care about life in my old age; I'd rather die."

We told her that God loves her and she is special in God's eyes. We gave her an audio Bible which contains some Bible books, number of teachings and some worship

songs. Tserev was so eager to listen to this audio Bible and asked us to charge it right away. We charged the audio Bible using the solar battery and helped her to get acquainted with this gadget.

Before we left her home we prayed for her well-being and safety of her children and grandchildren. We promised to keep in touch through phone. Grandmother Tserev treated us as if we were her own children. She packed us some khuushuur and boortsog for us to eat later. This was a sign of her gratitude and love. I saw her praying with her hands

extended towards us as we left her ger. **Please pray** for Tserev's faith in God to grow. Pray for her health and protection, and the salvation of her children. Pray for God to work in the hearts of those who heard the Good News through the "Gift of Love" project and open their hearts. Pray for courage to continue visiting such needy people and continue sharing my faith with them.
